“THE BIGGER GOD GETS IN YOUR LIFE, THE SMALLER GOLIATH BECOMES.”

READ

1 Samuel 17:47, Zechariah 4:6

A “giant” is something that appears too big. It is a situation that frightens you. It’s when you find yourself at a place saying, “There’s no way out of this!” You can’t find a solution. You’re stuck. You’re alone. That “Goliath” even seems bigger than your God. You will not defeat Goliath because you are older, wiser, more experienced or because you’re a tough guy.
