“COULD IT BE THAT GOD WOULD STOP EVERYTHING IN HEAVEN TO HEAR SOMETHING ON EARTH?”

READ

Matthew 16:19, Revelation 8:1-6

In this Revelation passage, six seals have been opened. With each one, man is destroying himself. But when He opens the seventh seal, the Bible tells us there will be silence in heaven for about a half an hour. Since creation, heaven has been filled with noises, thunders, and creatures praising God. The volume! But here the Father says, “Shh.” He’s telling a raptured church to hush. Why the silence? God is listening for something. An angel appears with incense. God throws the incense on the coals of the golden altar representing our salvation. Then the prayers of the saints mix with the incense, and God says, “Ah, yes.” God shuts down heaven to hear the prayers of the saints, people that were saved during the tribulation. They are crying out to God: “Avenge us.” God is going to do something on the earth next. But He doesn’t do it until He hears the prayers of the saints. Could it be that God, before He does something in your house, is waiting to hear that kind of prayer mixed with the aroma of your rejoicing?
